



NI Active Kids Parent Information Flyer

What is NI Active Kids?

NI Active Kids is a trial program designed to encourage and support school aged children living on Norfolk Island to be physically active. All children currently enrolled at the Norfolk Island Central School are eligible to apply for a \$100 NI Active Kids Voucher. This \$100 voucher can be used for their choice of one sport or other activity provided by registered local providers on Norfolk Island within a 12 month period.

Who can apply?

To be eligible for NI Active Kids children must be currently enrolled at the Norfolk Island Central School. All school age children are eligible for a \$100 NI Active Kids Voucher.

How do I apply for and use the voucher?

Application forms can be collected from NI-Connect, located in the Bounty Centre on Taylors Road, or you can email niactivekids@hospital.gov.nf and a form will be emailed to you or the form can be found at the NIHRACS website (www.norfolkislandhealth.gov.nf).

Once you have filled in the relevant details, please return the completed form to NI-Connect or email to the address above. Your NI Active Kids Voucher can be collected from NI-Connect. Please allow two working days for your voucher to be prepared. You then need to check with your sport or activity provider if they are registered with NI Active Kids and if they are you then present the voucher to the registered provider in lieu of payment.

Main Points for NI Active Kids

- ✓ Vouchers are valid 01 May 2019 – 30 April 2020
- ✓ One voucher per eligible child to the value of \$100
- ✓ Providers must be registered with NI Active Kids in order for the voucher to be used
- ✓ The voucher can only be used for one provider. If the provider fees are less than \$100 the remaining balance is forfeited
- ✓ Students must be currently enrolled at Norfolk Island Central School. NI Active Kids may seek your permission to contact the school to verify enrolment
