### **NIHRACS COVID-19 Update**

#### **COVID-19 Vaccines now available for children aged 5 – 11 years.**

There will be dedicated COVID-19 vaccination clinics for children aged 5-11 years from Monday 31 January – Wednesday February 2. Bookings are essential. If you haven't received a call about your child(ren)'s appointment please call the GP Clinic on 24134 or 22091 to book an appointment. There is some very useful information on this Pfizer vaccination program on the NIHRACS website ([www.norfolkislandhealth.gov.nf](http://www.norfolkislandhealth.gov.nf)) under the COVID-19 tab. This information sheet also contains the consent form. This consent form needs to be completed and brought along to the vaccination clinic. It is different to the 12 year-old child and over consent form.

#### **General Information Guide for People in Isolation/Quarantine**

#### **Sydney Breast Clinic on Island 7-11 February**

The Breast Screening clinic, conducted by Sydney Breast Clinic, will be held at the Hospital from Monday 7 until Friday 11 February. Please call the GP Clinic on 24134 or 22091 for an appointment.

Women aged 40 years and over should have a screening mammogram every two years. Those who have the BrCa gene, or who have been advised to do so at their last screening, should have a screen every year.
