About the service

NIHRACS is a multipurpose service including a General Practice Clinic, Outpatients, Emergency Service, 6 Acute beds and 10 Residential Aged Care Beds. The service operates from a combined small hospital/GP clinic setting within a multipurpose service model.

About the role

The Norfolk Island Health and Residential Aged Care Service (NIHRACS) is currently seeking a Radiographer permanent part-time (55 hours / fortnight) to provide radiography services to Norfolk Island Health and Residential Aged Care Service (NIHRACS) patients with the objective of providing best quality outcomes.

The Radiographer will be responsible for the operational management of the radiology service, including Radiation Safety, Picture Archiving and Communication System Administration (PACS) and Quality Improvement with the Norfolk Island Hospital and for high quality radiology services to patients of the Norfolk Island Hospital.

The selection criteria for this position are as follows:

- Current statement of accreditation with the Australian Society of Medical Imaging and Radiation Therapy (ASMIRT) and registration with the Medical Radiation Practitioner Board of Australia.
- Possession of NSW Office of Environment and Heritage issued Radiation Licence IA14 for the use of irradiating equipment for medical diagnostic procedures.
- Demonstrated experience in the management of the resources, equipment and technology of a medical imaging department, including the implementation of quality control programs and PACS Administration.
- Demonstrated extensive clinical skills in performing comprehensive radiographic procedures.
- Ability to work as part of a multi-disciplinary team and to exercise independent professional judgements on routine matters, commensurate with years of experience.

- Demonstrated high level interpersonal written and oral communication skills.
- Demonstrated understanding of the challenges involved in working in a remote area.
