If you have multiple issues or you think they are complex and will require extensive discussion, please let our receptionist know that you would like a **long appointment**. This will ensure you have the time needed with your GP and will assist us in managing the GPs time and patient flow.

Please notify us as soon as you can if you are unable to make your appointment time. This allows us to offer the time to another patient. A quick phone call if you are running late also allows for better management of our patient times.
