Endometriosis Awareness Month

NIHRACS draws attention to the challenges faced by women with endometriosis and adenomyosis. Women experiencing pelvic pain, irregular menstruation, or fatigue are encouraged to seek evaluation. Our GP's and allied health team work collaboratively to provide tailored support and referrals for specialist care. Early recognition and intervention can significantly improve quality of life.

National Diabetes Services Scheme (NDSS)

The NDSS aims to enhance the capacity of people with diabetes to understand and self-manage their life with diabetes. NDSS subsidised products are available through NDSS Access Points (pharmacies). Norfolk Island Pharmacy is an NDSS Access Point.

Registration with the NDSS is free for all eligible individuals and only needs to be done once by a diabetes educator, practice nurse or GP. If you would like to speak with the NDSS helpline, call 1800 637 700 or review the NDSS website <https://www.ndss.com.au>.

GP Management Plans for Diabetes

Managing diabetes effectively requires a structured approach, and at NIHRACS, our Chronic Disease Nurse – Carter Stormann can provide tailored support for individuals living with diabetes. A GP Management Plan (GPMP) is a personalised healthcare plan developed to help monitor and manage your condition. This plan includes regular check-ups, referrals to allied health professionals such as our dietitian, podiatrist, and physiotherapist, and assistance with medication management.
